





Kinross Wheelchair Curling Club – funding given - £500:

Founded in 2001, Kinross Wheelchair Curling Club made history as Scotland's (and the UK's) first ever wheelchair curling club. The sport is open to anyone who uses a wheelchair for sport, or those who cannot safely participate on their feet.

One of the clubs founding members had previously been an abled bodied curler, and after an accident at work, found wheelchair curling was a great alternative for them to continue playing the sport that they loved. Receiving £500 through the Aldi Scottish Sports Fund, Kinross continue to invite new members to the club and support its few able bodied voluntary 'on ice assistants' who provide vital support.
